OUR LOVING SAVIOR

- HE LEFT THEM (AND US) AN EXAMPLE TO FOLLOW
- WE RECEIVE A BLESSING WHEN WE FOLLOW HIS EXAMPLE
- A SERVANT IS NOT ABOVE HIS MASTER
 - IF THE MASTER IS WILLING TO SERVE, SHOULDN'T WE BE WILLING TO SERVE ONE ANOTHER?

THE EXAMPLE

• When no one else was willing to serve, Jesus chose to do the "dirty work."

THE OBJECT LESSON

• Jesus used this living example to teach a second important spiritual truth.

• Jesus informed them that those who belong to Him have a need for ongoing cleansing from the defilements of this world.

• Jesus also let them know He had provided a way to meet this need.

Do you want to have a loving relationship with the living God?

Trust Jesus for Eternal Life (John 3:16)

Do you want to continue to enjoy rich fellowship with Jesus?

Confess your sin and receive His ongoing forgiveness and cleansing (1 John 1:9)

THE BREAD

• Jesus said this is My Body which is broken for you...

THE CUP

• This cup is the New Covenant in my Blood....
