# UNMEASURED BLESSINGS

MALACHI 3:7-12

Is there anyone here who does not desire the blessing (or favor) of the Lord in their lives?

Do we realize God's blessing (favor) is often conditioned upon our obedience to His revealed Word?

## MALACHI 3:7-12

<sup>7</sup> "From the days of your fathers you have turned aside from My statutes and have not kept them. Return to Me, and I will return to you," says the LORD of hosts. "But you say, 'How shall we return?' <sup>8</sup> "Will a man rob God? Yet you are robbing Me! But you say, 'How have we robbed You?' In tithes and offerings. <sup>9</sup> You are cursed with a curse, for you are robbing Me, the whole nation of you!

### MALACHI 3:7-12

 <sup>10</sup> Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, so that there may be food in My house, and test Me now in this," says the LORD of hosts, "if I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you a blessing until it overflows.

## MALACHI 3:7-12

<sup>11</sup> Then I will rebuke the devourer for you, so that it will not destroy the fruits of the ground; nor will your vine in the field cast *its grapes*," says the LORD of hosts. <sup>12</sup> "All the nations will call you blessed, for you shall be a delightful land," says the LORD of hosts.

# GOD'S INDICTMENT vs 7a

You have strayed from my commandments.

## GOD'S CALL vs 7b

#### Return to Me!

- Acknowledge where you have gone astray
- Make the appropriate course correction

# GOD'S PROMISE vs 7b

 IF you return to Me, THEN I will return to you.

- Had God moved? Not really!
  - But He had removed His hand of blessing and favor from their lives as a community.
- Many of God's promises are conditional.
  - Having His favor is a conditional promise.

# GOD'S EVIDENCE vs 8-9

#### THE PEOPLE HAD BEEN ROBBING GOD!

#### THE THEFT

Withholding their tithes and offerings.

 In doing so, they had neglected their responsibility to provide for God's appointed Priests. (Lev. 8:31; 24:5-9)

 In doing so, they had caused there to be a lack of resources to care for the widows and orphans. (Deut. 14:28-29)

#### THE CONSEQUENCES

The people were not experiencing God's hand of favor/blessing!

 The people were actually under a curse by God, as He had promised. (Deut. 28:15-68, esp. vs 47)

# GOD'S CALL EXPLAINED vs 10

- A rare call to put the Lord to the "test".
  - See if He is faithful to keep His promises!

- The real test was; did they (do we) trust the Lord to provide for their (our) needs?
- Would they be willing to do things God's way even if it didn't make sense?

GOD'S PROMISES EXPLAINED vs 11-12

- God would "rebuke" the devourer.
  - The ground would produce abundant crops
  - The vines would also produce fruit in abundance

- All the nations will call you blessed.
  - The nations around will see the benefits of serving the Living God.

- God still desires that we give, from His resources entrusted to us, so that we provide for the widows, the orphans and those less fortunate.
  - James 1:27 with Acts 6:1
- Pure and undefiled religion is; taking care of the Widows and Orphans in their time of need...
- Widows were being cared for in the early church, the gifts were given by the people and administered by the leaders.

 God still desires that we give, from His resources entrusted to us, so that we provide for those who work hard at preaching the word.

#### • 1 Tim. 5:17-18

 An Elder who works hard at preaching and teaching is worthy of double honor

A workman is worthy of his wage

#### • How much should we give?

- A typical starting point is 10%.
  - This was clearly commanded under the Mosaic Covenant
  - This is still implied by Jesus in Mt. 23:23
- Give as you purpose in your heart.
- Give willingly and cheerfully.

How much should we give?
MOST IMPORTANTLY...

- Give as you purpose in your heart.
  - Be intentional and thoughtful in your giving.
- Give willingly and cheerfully.
  - Don't allow others to pressure you into giving.

God still desires that we "trust Him" to provide for our needs.

• Matthew 6:19-34

- Store up treasure in the heavenlies.
- Do not be anxious about the provisions needed for this life.
- Seek first His Kingdom.
- Seek first His righteousness.

Trust Him to take care of you needs as you prioritize
 obedience and trust.
