PSALM 119

THE WRITER

- UNKNOWN AUTHOR
 - TWO LIKELY CANDIDATES: JEREMIAH; DANIEL
 - WHAT WE DO KNOW IS THE AUTHOR HAD AN INTENSE HUNGER FOR God and His word.

THEME

- Clearly the theme is the priority of the Word of God for His children.
- God's word is mentioned in some form in all but five verses. (84, 90, 121, 122, 132)
- The Psalm is in the form of an acrostic. There are 22 stanzas corresponding to the letters in the Hebrew alphabet.

VERSES I & 2

• How blessed are those whose way is blameless,

Who walk in the law of the LORD. ² How blessed

are those who observe His testimonies, Who seek

Him with all their heart.

 "How can a young man keep his way pure? By keeping it according to your Word."

 "With all my heart I have sought You; Do not let me wander from Your commandments."

VERSE II

 "Your word I have treasured in my heart, That I may not sin against You."

 "The Lord is my portion; I have promised to keep Your words."

 "The law of Your mouth is better to me Than thousands of gold and silver pieces."

"I will never forget Your precepts, For by them
 You have revived me."

VERSE 97-100

 O how I love Your law! It is my meditation all the day. 98 Your commandments make me wiser than my enemies, For they are ever mine. 99 I have more insight than all my teachers, For Your testimonies are my meditation. 100 I understand more than the aged, Because I have observed Your precepts.

 "Your word is a lamp to my feet And a light to my path."

 "My eyes fail with longing for Your salvation And for Your righteous word."

VERSE 140 & 142

- "Your word is very pure, Therefore Your servant loves it."
- "Your righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, And Your law is truth."

"Those who love Your law have great peace,
 And nothing causes them to stumble."
